CONSUMER NOTICE

WISCONSIN HOMELESS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

The Emergency Shelter of the Fox Valley receives funding from U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and/or the State of Wisconsin Department of Commerce to provide services for homeless and near homeless individuals and their families. A requirement of this funding is that the Emergency Shelter of the Fox Valley participates in the Wisconsin Homeless Management Information System. This system collects basic information about clients receiving services from this agency. This requirement was enacted in order to get a more accurate count of individuals and families who are homeless and to identify the need for different services.

We only collect and share the information that we consider to be appropriate. The collection and use of all personal information is guided by strict standards of confidentiality. A copy of our Privacy Notice describing our privacy practice is available to all consumers upon request.

The Emergency Shelter of the Fox Valley client information will be shared with other area agencies that participate in the network unless a client requests that their information remain confidential and be only available to the Emergency Shelter of the Fox Valley. Clients may talk to a house supervisor about keeping records closed if they are interested.
